LAMP Makeover

Over the past year, LAMP has indentified a common difficulty encountered by students. Now more than ever, students are finding it hard to make a long term commitment to their education. We recognized that most adult students have competing priorities between work, family and church. In order to address this issue, LAMP has separated the requirements needed for the Masters (M.Div.) and the Bachelors (B.Div.) program.

Here are some of the changes:

- We have adjusted the M.Div. program to meet the credit requirement for that degree.
 - ⇒ What that means is that M.Div. students will only have take 162 quarter credits (instead of the original 180) which are equal to a standard M.Div. program at other seminaries.
 - ⇒ This gives the opportunity for M.Div. students to complete the program in 5 years instead of 6 years.
- We adjusted the credit for each course to be equal to the academic standards for each course.
 - ⇒ What that means is that some courses will be worth 5 credits while other courses will be 3 credits.
- We are now only requiring one GLEE per year, however; students will not progress to the next year unless this requirement is met.
- We have added electives to the B.Div. program in order to meet the credit requirements for that degree (180 quarter credits).
 - ⇒ These elective credits can be accomplished through a variety of ways. Please contact LAMP for more information.

LAMP is adjusting the current student transcripts to fit the new program criteria so that all of our students can take advantage of these changes.
